About this project

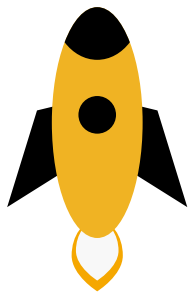
Over the last few years, Amala has developed expertise in providing transformative educational opportunities for displaced youth aged 16-25. We have seen that there is a big need for education programmes that break away from traditional topics and pedagogies, and for new tools that educators can use to engage displaced learners, particularly those who have been out of school for some time and find it hard to get back into learning.

Through this project, Amala aims to collaborate with organisations and educators around Greece to enable more displaced youth to follow Amala short courses on topics like Ethical Leadership, Peacebuilding in your Community and Social Entrepreneurship. Amala will offer Amala's facilitator training to interested organisations and educators to help them build their capacity and competencies to deliver transformational learning experiences. Following the training, we will support organisations to launch and run Amala short courses in the communities where they work. As part of this programme, a limited amount of funding is available to support partners who would not be able to run Amala courses without such support.

How can you be involved?



Participate in a 6-hour training to facilitate Amala's transformational learning course



Run one of Amala's 5 or 10 week courses for members of your community



Receive ongoing professional development support through support sessions and coaching



How do you benefit from this project?

- Grow your capacity to deliver learning that enables displaced learners to take action for positive change in their communities, and your provision of programmes for youth.
- Organisations and educators participating in this project will become part of a larger network of education changemakers around Greece and globally who work to offer innovative, agency-based learning to displaced youth.
- Gain access to Amala's innovative curriculum in a range of topics which break with more frequently encountered language-focused curricula, and support on how to implement it.
- Support to re-engage those learners who have faced a disproportionate amount of obstacles in getting back into education and find it very difficult to engage and commit to any type of educational activity.
