

Information on service provision in “Adama Center”

Catholic Relief Services and Caritas Hellas, with the support of United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees, are launching the “Adama Center”, a center which provides in-person and remote integration services to asylum seekers and beneficiaries of international protection (BIP) living in Greece. The center will be operated by Caritas Hellas staff to support eligible beneficiaries with their applications for existing national social protection schemes and to link them with job opportunities. Recognizing the challenges asylum seekers and refugees face to access safe and dignified livelihoods opportunities even after their long-term residency in the country, CRS and Caritas Hellas are providing targeted services to promote self-reliance and autonomy.

More specifically the service provision of Adama Center includes the following:

- Information on Greek labor market and job counseling sessions
- Linkages with available job opportunities all over Greece
- Information and assistance in collecting the necessary documentation to apply for welfare allowances (such as the Minimum Guarantee Income).
- Coordination and referrals to other actors, as appropriate

Please note that the center will be applying an appointment policy following referrals from other actors as well as self-referrals. Kindly note that the center is providing interpretation support and services in English, Farsi, Arabic, French, Sorani and Kurmanji.
